

CYB General Policies

Last Revised: 2/19/2015

Registration: Each player must be registered with the League before he is allowed to play in any league games. A player is considered registered with the League when all his fees are paid. Exceptions must be approved by the League President.

Scholarships: Requests for scholarships must be made via the Scholarship Request Form available on the league web site and submitted in person before the registration deadline. The League President or any board member designated by the President has the authority to review and grant all scholarship requests.

Family Discounts: When more than two members of the same family register, each additional member is half-price. The discount is given on the lowest price registration(s).

Age Exceptions: Players may "play up" (i.e. play in the next higher division than is standard for the player's age) if the age difference is less than one year with the approval of the division coordinator. If the age difference is more than one year, approval is required from the board. Players may "play down" (i.e. play in the next lower division) only in rare circumstances (e.g. special needs situation) and only with the approval of the board.

Age Verification: Each player must present a copy of his birth certificate to the league. Any player whose birth date has not been verified may not play in any league games.

Switching Teams: There are a number of factors involved when a player switches from one team to another. CYB highly discourages this and it is only allowed under certain circumstances with board approval.

Uniforms: Shirts & hats are provided for all players. Socks are provided for all Mustang, Bronco, Pony, & Colt players in the spring. Three coach shirts and hats are provided for each team.

Umpire Ages: Umpires for Shetland games must be at least 14 years old. Umpires for Pinto games must be at least 16 years old. The Umpire Coordinator can make exceptions if additional umpires are needed and those available do not meet the age requirement.

Awards: In the spring season trophies are given to all players in the Shetland & Pinto divisions. For all other divisions in the spring season, regular season trophies are awarded to each player for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place if there are six or more teams, 1st & 2nd place if there are four or five teams, and 1st place if there are two or three teams. No trophies are awarded if there is only one team. In addition, medals are awarded for 1st & 2nd place in post-season tournaments if there are at least four teams; otherwise, only 1st place medals are awarded. No awards are given out in the fall season
